You will also visit the traditional district of Yanahuara, where you can enjoy panoramic views of the city and its three guardian volcanoes: Misti, Chachani, and

Pichu Pichu.

ITINERARY:

Our experience begins with pickup from your hotel in the city of Arequipa. We will start at Carmen Alto, a charming viewpoint offering panoramic views of the city and its green countryside, an ideal place to enjoy nature and capture beautiful photographs. We will then continue to the Yanahuara Viewpoint, famous for its volcanic stone arches that frame the majestic volcanoes surrounding the city. Nearby, we will explore its picturesque square and colonial church.

Next, we will stroll through the Callejón de la Casa Encantada and Callejón Toledo, two beautiful spots rich in history, art, and tradition. We will then visit the Cathedral of Arequipa, an elegant symbol of colonial architecture, and the lovely Plaza de Armas, surrounded by historic arcades and monuments that tell the story of the city's past.

Our journey continues to the Monastery of Santa Catalina, known as a city within a city, reflecting centuries of devotion and monastic life. Finally, we will visit the Church and Cloisters of the Compañía de Jesús, masterpieces of mestizo baroque art that combine artistry, spirituality, and the living essence of Arequipa. At the end of our experience through the White City, we will take you back to your hotel.


